

LNG terminal at Kakinada

KAKINADA: The Union government has agreed in principle to establish an LNG terminal in Kakinada. A Memorandum of Understanding in this regard will be signed by the representatives of the Central and the State governments in Vijayawada on September 25, according to Tota Narasimham, Kakinada MP and member of the consultative committee on the Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas.

According to a press release issued by Mr. Narasimham's office here on Monday, the committee took the decision to establish the CNG in Kakinada during its meeting in Mumbai. The press release further said that replacement works of the GAIL's pipeline would be completed by the year end and the allocation of gas to the industries in East Godavari district would be revised very soon.
